

Discussion Task Self-assessment Checklist

Discussion Director

- ⊗ **Did you include an MLA heading at the top of your paper?**
- ⊗ **Did you include a title indicating the book and assigned chapters?**
- ⊗ Are the questions typed?
- ⊗ Did you ask 10-15 questions?
- ⊗ Do the questions relate to the *big ideas*?
- ⊗ Do the questions span different question levels?
- ⊗ Are the questions open-ended so they can generate conversation?

Passage Master:

- ⊗ **Did you include an MLA heading at the top of your paper?**
- ⊗ **Did you include a title indicating the book and assigned chapters?**
- ⊗ Did you use the correct, typed, 3-column format, assigning reading jobs for group members? (see example on instruction sheet)
- ⊗ Did you provide an in-depth analysis of at least 5 passages?
- ⊗ Are passages significant (*not* random)?
 - Present conflict
 - Provide character detail
 - Foreshadow future event
 - Create personal/literature connection
 - Present an important symbol
 - Include a recurring idea/action/event/theme/message

Illustrator:

- ⊗ Did you use one of the following formats?
 - Gift list + visual
 - Collage
 - Map
 - Digital slideshow
- ⊗ Does the illustration go beyond a superficial examination of the text?
- ⊗ Does the final product demonstrate effort, organization, and depth?
- ⊗ Did you include a **typed** explanation for at least 10 elements included in your visual?
- ⊗ **Did you include an MLA heading at the top of your paper?**
- ⊗ **Did you include a title indicating the book and assigned chapters?**

Connector:

- ⊗ **Did you format the reflection according to all MLA guidelines?**
- ⊗ **Did you attach a Works Cited page?**
- ⊗ **Did you include a title indicating the book and assigned chapters?**
- ⊗ Did you make a connection with at least one other work and explain the thematic significance of the connection?
- ⊗ Did you correctly cite at least one quote from the book to support your ideas?
