Characters

Symbols

Be able to discuss the author's use of symbolism in the novel. Consider the following question: What actions or objects seem to stand for something? What do they signify for the characters in the book? For the reader?

Thematic passages

Be able to discuss the novel's themes. Consider the following question: What does the novel suggests about human nature, life, and society? How does the author convey such messages?

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
